SCE&G KEEPS PROMISE TO LAKE USERS.....

LMA invited Jim Landreth, Vice President of Hydro and Fossil Fuel for SCE&G to speak on concerns relating to multi-slip docks. Due to the dramatic increase in Multi slip dock proposals, many concerns have been raised as to the impact on water quality, boating safety, lake access and usage.

In the course of the discussion at Newberry, Mr. Landreth promised to take these concerns to the management of SCE&G in an effort to arrive at an updated and reasonable resolution for dock permitting

As a result of these efforts, SCE&G informed The Lake Murray Association and issued a press release Wednesday that a moratorium had been established.

LMA president, Lee Barber, after attending numerous meetings addressing these problems expressed his pleasure and gratitude at SCE&Gs timely response to this growing problem. This moratorium will give SCE&G and lake users time to assess and address the impact of multi slip docks on recreation and the environment.

He added, "This type of positive response by SCE&G to lake concerns is greatly appreciated."
